



## 2008-2009 ITBS Results

St. Louis is very proud of our recent ITBS test results. You can see that the investment you are making in your child's education is paying off in rigorous academic achievement.

Grades 2-8 took the Iowa Test of Basic Skills, ITBS, in mid February. This is a national standardized test. The norm for students would be for them to perform at the same grade level as their current grade level. The test was taken in February thus the norm would be the child's current grade level plus 6 months (example: 3<sup>rd</sup> graders would score at 3.6).

The average for each subject at each grade level was above the norm.

2<sup>nd</sup> grade is over a year above the norm in reading!

3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grades are over a year above the norm in SS and Science.

5<sup>th</sup> grade is a year above the norm in all subjects!

6<sup>th</sup> grade is a year above the norm in Language Arts

7<sup>th</sup> grade is at least a year above in all areas

8<sup>th</sup> grade is at least two years above the norm in all areas
