**Thank You For Voting**

We had 81% of our parents vote regarding the proposed change to the Home & School By-Laws and Constitution. 86 of our 106 parents voted, that exceeds the 2/3 required, which would be 71 votes. WELL DONE!

11 voted to keep the term of office for the treasurer at one year as it is currently written. 75 voted to change the term of office to a two-year term. The 75 individuals who voted in favor of the proposed amendment meet the 2/3 affirmative obligation and thus the amendment passes. The office of Treasurer for Home & School will now be a two year term.

Char Noland took the oath of office for the second year of her term as treasurer at the Home & School meeting held on June 2, 2010.

*ARTICLE VII, Section 4, item #2 of the Home & School Bylaws indicates "Bylaws may be amended by the affirmative vote of 2/3 of the voting General Membership ". ARTICLE VIII, Section 2 states "These Bylaws may be amended by 2/3 vote of the General Membership, provided the substance of such proposed amendment or amendments shall be made known and published to the General Membership two weeks prior to voting.*
