**Ash Wednesday and Good Friday:** These are days of Fast and abstinence from meat. There is a limit of one full meal on these days for all between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

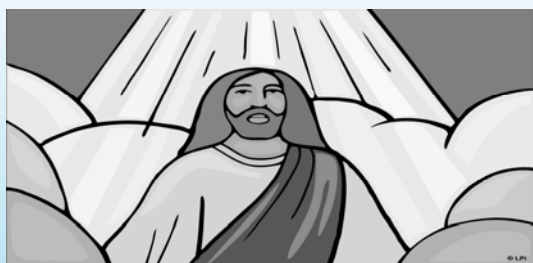
**St. Louis Alumni News**
