**St. Louis Technology**

As technology continues to expand, one of the new components to seventh grade is wordle. A good definition of a wordle is a word cloud. The word cloud gives greater emphasis to words used more frequently than other words from a particular text. Because safety is foremost in our use of the Internet here at St. Louis, the wordle site is blocked. So, some seventh and eighth grade students got creative and used text boxes in PowerPoint to create their own version of a wordle. Using Psalm 150 as the basis, they were also aloud to stretch the rules of a true wordle to emphasize what they thought should receive more emphasis.
